**SECOND WORLD WAR EXPERIENCE CENTRE**

Would you like to share your memories of the war, for inclusion in The Centre's archive? We aren't looking for dramatic tales of glory - we are looking for stories from all walks of life, including servicemen and women, but also from civilians, children, factory workers, or anyone who has wartime memories.



The recording is made in an informal setting and then sent to the Centre for transcribing and inclusion in the archive, which is accessible by authors working on Second World War books, by TV researchers, by Post-Graduate and Undergraduate researchers, and is also used by veterans groups and historical societies. It is currently developing educational modules for use by schools, and has recently provided source material for the Scottish Holocaust Memorial Exhibition in Edinburgh. The Centre is a registered museum and charity, and exists to document the lives of men and women who lived through the 1939-1945 years. More than 7000 people have their younger years covered in the Centre by original documents, memorabilia and recorded memories. It's website can be found at <http://www.war-experience.org>.
