A photograph of Einstein and the equation $E=mc^2$ are surely two of the most widely recognised symbols of the 20th century. 2005 is the centenary of the publication of that equation. Einstein's work on relativity made him science's first international superstar. His work on quantum theory was hugely influential and his views on its meaning still resonate.
