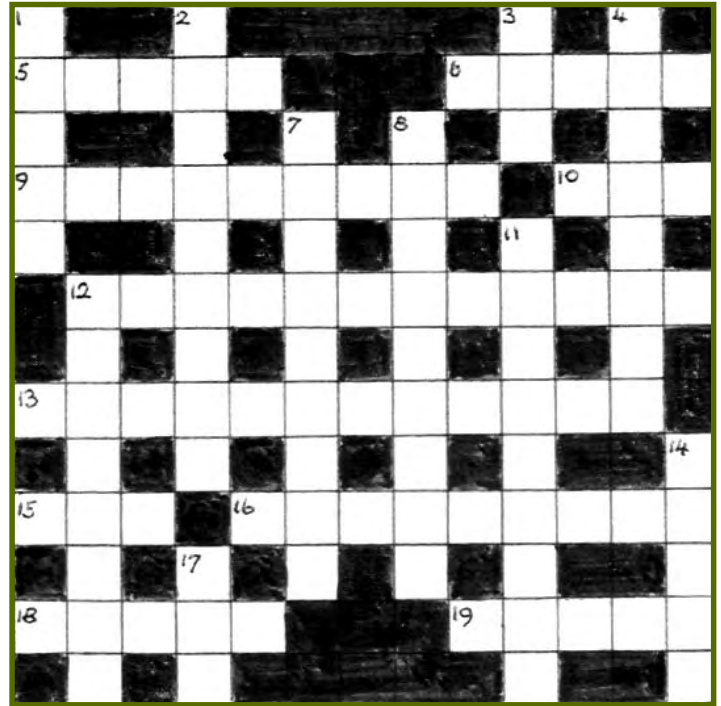
MARCHAM PRE-SCHOOL NEWS
